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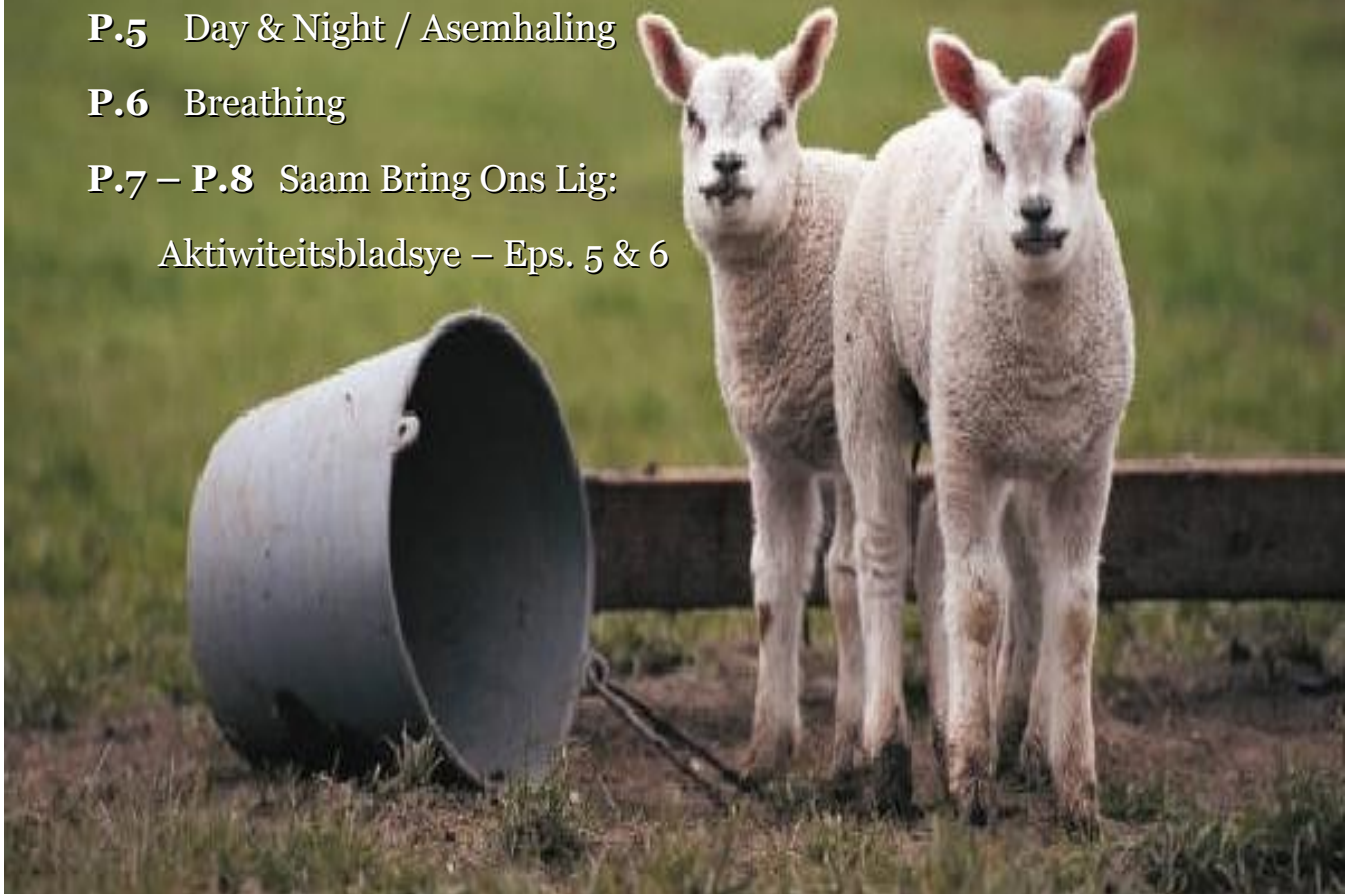

Liewe Maats,

GEBED

‘n Sondagskool onderwyser het eendag gevra: “Bid jy elke dag?” ‘n Dogtertjie het vinnig geantwoord: “Natuurlik nie, want daar is dae wat ek niks wil hê nie!”

Daar is baie mese wat soos die dogtertjie is. Hul bid net wanneer hul iets nodig het. Nou hoe kan ons sê ons het Jesus lief as ons nie met Hom praat nie? Hoe kan ons meer van God verwag as ons Hom nie dankie sê vir wat Hy reeds gegee of gedoen het nie? Toe ons klein was en iets by iemand gekry het, het ons ma’s dikwels met groot oë gesê: “Wat sê jy, sê dankie” Ek wil jou ook herrinner om God te dank vir Sy skepping en ook om Jesus te dank vir die grootste geskenk ooit, die ewige lewe.

Om te bid is nie dieselfde as om ‘n “wenslys” vir kersvader te stuur nie. Gebed is meer as ‘n lys van dinge wat ons nodig het. In die eerste plek moet ons dankie sê vir dit wat ons reeds het. Kom ons doen dit sommer nou: “Dankie Heer dat U vir ons lewe gegee het. Dankie vir gesondheid, kos en klere. Dankie vir ouers, broers en susters. Dankie vir ons skool, ons onderwysers en al ons vriende. Dankie vir ‘n kerk waar ons van U kan leer. Ek is so bly, ek verheug myself in die wete dat U vir ons omgee” Nou gaan ons bid vir ons behoeftes, dit wat ons van God verlang: “Heer, leer my meer van U, wys my wat ek moet wees, doen en sê. Beskerm ons en voorsien vir ons. Ons vra alles in Jesus naam – Amen”

Die Woord sê ook dat ons moet glo (geloof hê of op op God moet vertrou) wanneer ons bid. Kom ons kyk gou na [*Filipense 4:6*](#) *Maak in alles julle begeertes deur gebed en smeking en met danksegging aan God bekend.* Wanneer ons glo, kan ons God iets vra en terselfdertyd dankie sê. Ja, ons sê dankie en raak bly, nog voordat ons dit gekry het waarvoor ons gevra het. Begin om die Heer dankie te sê vir goeie punte, goeie gesondheid en voorsiening en kyk hoe God jou gebede verhoor.

Kom ons bid: “Dankie Heer vir alles wat U reeds vir my gegee het en dankie vir al swat U nog vir my gaan doen – Amen”

PRAYER

One day the Sunday school teacher asked: “Do you pray every day?” A girl quickly answered: “Off cause not, for there are days that I need nothing”

This is true of many people. They only pray when they need something from God. Is this enough? No, how can we say we love Jesus if we



don't talk to Him? How can we expect Him to provide for us if we don't thank Him for the things He has done for us? When you were small, and somebody gave you something, your mother will look at you with big eyes and say: "What do you say? Say thank you". We should also thank God for what He has done and what He has given us. Just so we should thank Jesus for the great gift, eternal life" that He gave us by dying in our place.

Praying is not the same as writing a letter to Father Christmas. We should not be going to God with a wish list, forgetting what we already have. Let us thank God for all we have: "Thank you Lord for giving us life, thank you for giving us health, thank you for parents, brothers and sisters that care about us. Thank you for water, bread and all things nice to eat. Thank you for a school, and teachers and all our friends. Thank you, Lord, for a church where we can learn more about you. We're so glad, we rejoice because we know you care" Now let us pray for our needs: "Lord, learn me more about you. Show me what I should do, where I should go and what I should say. Protect us, help us and provide for us. I pray in Jesus name."

The Word also says we should believe or have faith when we pray. To see what faith is let us read *Philippians 4:6* *In all your prayers ask God for what you need, always asking him with a thankful heart.* When we have faith, we can ask God what we require and thank Him for that at the same time, even before we get what we have asked for. You see when we pray with faith we know God will answer therefore we can say thank you. Practice this, start thanking God for good marks at school, good health and even for good parent and see how the Lord will answer your prayers.

Let us pray: "Lord, I thank you for all you have given me and for all I am about to receive – Amen"

HAMBURGER & COKE

Sekere dinge hoort net eenvoudig bymekaar soos "pap en vleis", "brood en melk", "vis en skyfies", "Koek en tee" en "koffie en beskuit". Een van die mees bekende kombinasie bly egter "Hamburger en Coke" Dit is moeilik om 'n hamburger voor te stel sonder Coke.

Nog onafskeidbare kombinasies is "jy en Jesus" of "ek en Jesus". Net soos 'n hamburger sonder Coke net nie dieselfde is nie net so kan ek en jy nie sonder Jesus wees nie. Sien, Jesus gee betekenis aan ons lewens. Ons lewe maak eers sin as Jesus in ons is en ons in Hom. Kom ons lees *Johannes 15:4 - 7* " *Julle moet in My bly en Ek in julle. 'n Loot kan nie uit sy eie vrugte dra as hy nie aan die wingerdstok bly nie; en so julle ook nie as julle nie in My bly nie. Ek is die wingerdstok, julle die lote. Wie in My bly en Ek in hom, dra baie vrugte, want sonder My kan julle niks doen nie. As iemand nie in My bly nie, word hy weggegooi soos 'n loot en hy verdroog. Die mense maak sulke lote bymekaar en gooi dit in die vuur, en dit verbrand. As julle in My bly en my woorde in julle, vra dan net wat julle wil hê, en julle sal dit kry*"

Die loot, of sytakkie van die wingerdstok kan nie op sy eie bestaan nie. Die sytakkie trek sy voeding of krag uit die stam van die plant. Net so moet ek en jy in Jesus wees



want Hy gee vir ons voeding en krag. En met die krag van God in ons lewens kan ons vrug dra soos opgeteken in [Galasiërs 5:22-23](#).

Kom dan, kom ons wees hamburger en Coke christene, onafskeidbaar van mekaar, onafskeidbaar van Jesus, die ware wynstok.

HAMBURGER & COKE

Certain things simply goes together like “pie and gravy”, “bread and milk”, “fish and chips” and “tea and cake”. However the most common combination must be “Hamburger and en Coke”. I can’t imagine having a hamburger without Coke.

Another inseparable combination is “Jesus and you” or “Jesus and I”. Just like a hamburger is at its best when served with Coke, our relationship with Jesus brings out the best in us. Our lives only become meaningful or make sense when we are in Jesus and He is in us. Let us read [John 15:4 - 7](#) *Remain united to me, and I will remain united to you. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself; it can do so only if it remains in the vine. In the same way you cannot bear fruit unless you remain in me. "I am the vine, and you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me. Those who do not remain in me are thrown out like a branch and dry up; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire, where they are burned. If you remain in me and my words remain in you, then you will ask for anything you wish, and you shall have it.*

The branch cannot survive or bear fruit without the vine. The branch draws its strength or power to bear fruit from the vine. Just so we need to remain in Jesus. Jesus makes us complete. In Him we are able to produce fruit as seen in Galatians 5:22-23. Jesus brings out the best in us.

Let us be “hamburger and coke” Christians, inseparable from Jesus, the vine.

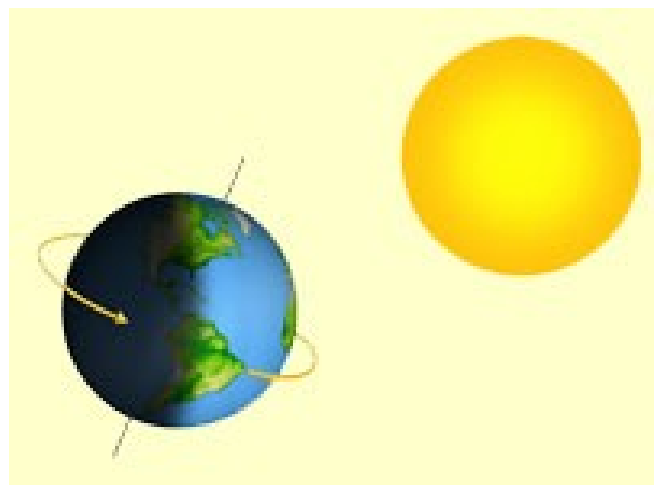
DAG EN NAG

Hang in there, God's light is shining and will shine upon you at the right time.

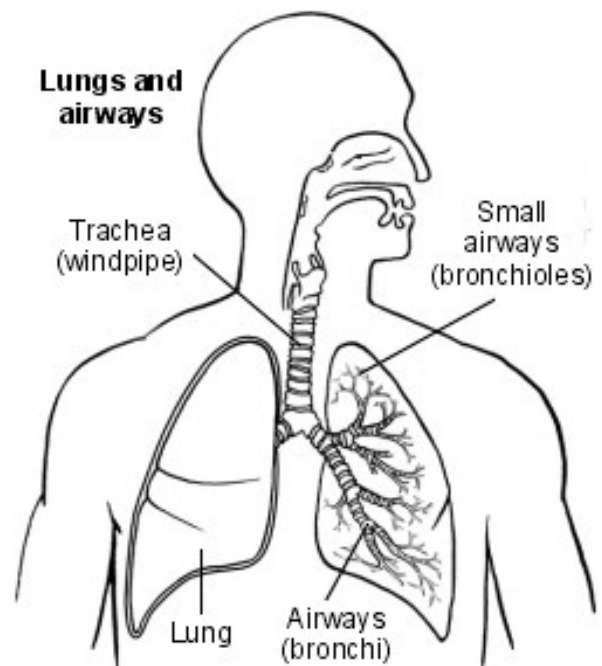
ASEMHALING

BREATHING

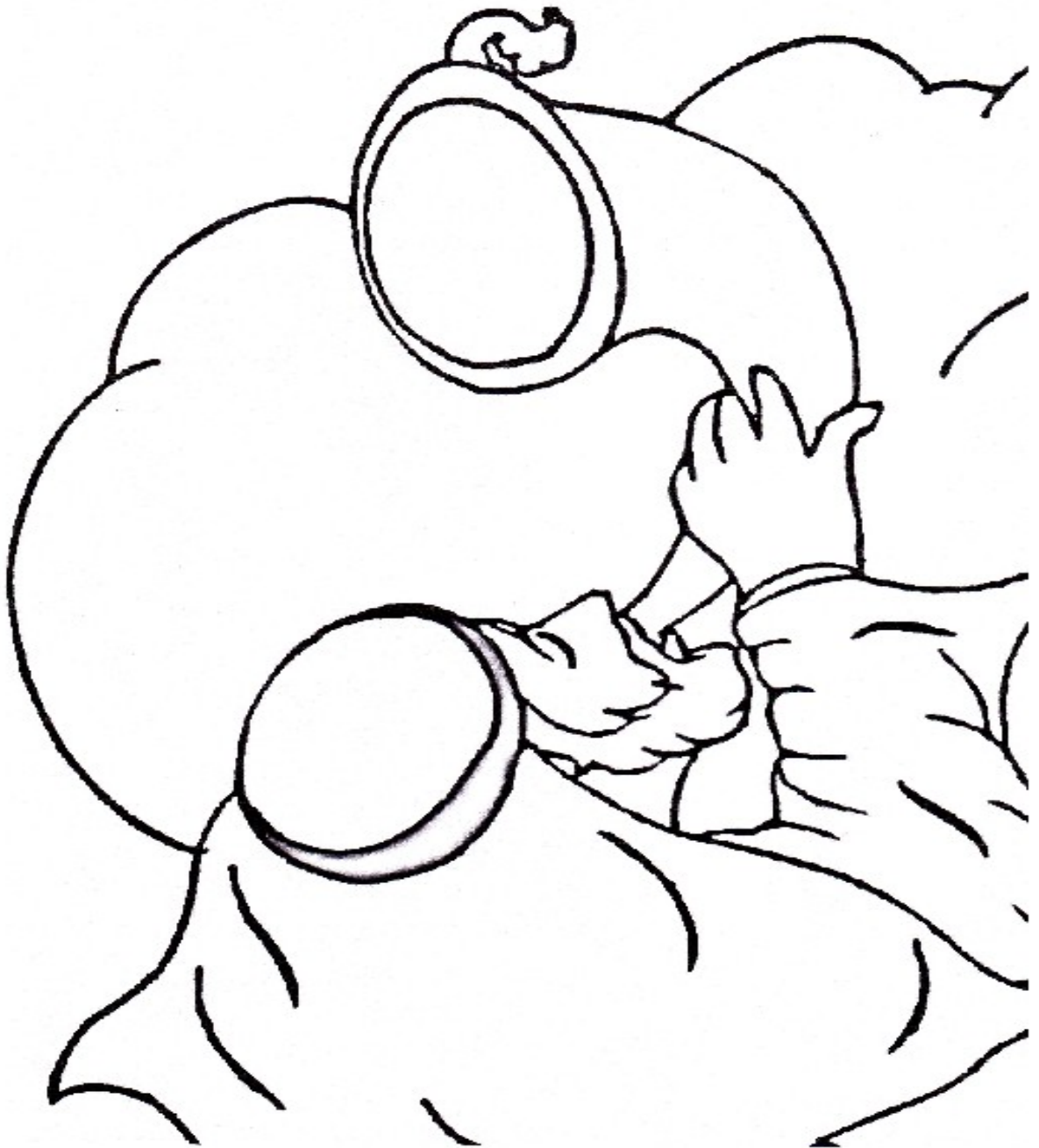

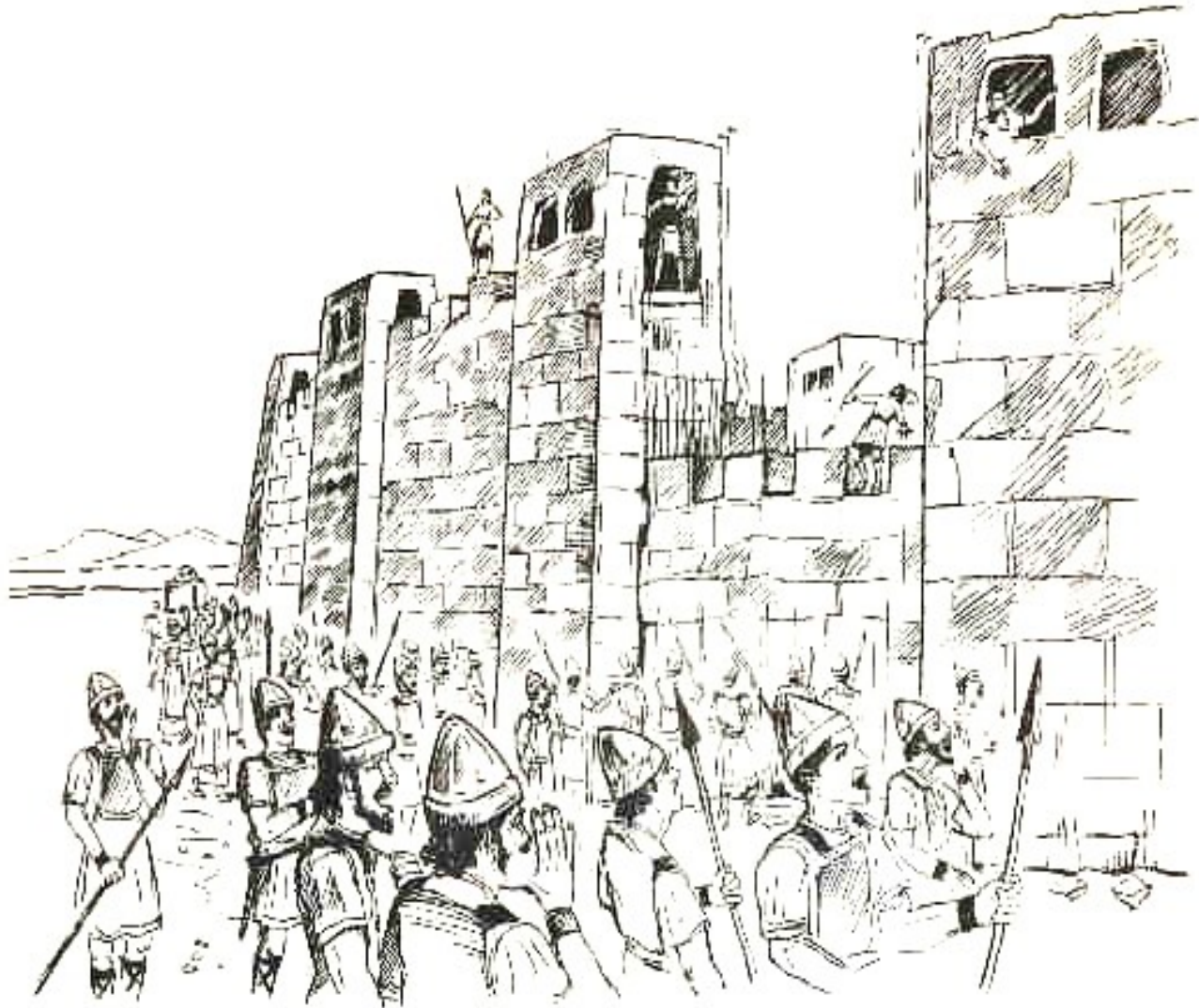
